She is a nurse who serves patients every day and makes a difference in the healthcare space. She has chosen to turn her incredibly difficult experience to raise awareness and support others impacted by cancer.

Scalp cooling helps prevent hair loss during chemotherapy by constricting blood vessels in the scalp and slowing the metabolic rate of hair follicles. This limits the amount of chemotherapy medication that reaches and damages hair cells.

Hair loss is not simply cosmetic. It is one of the most visible and emotionally difficult parts of cancer treatment. Preventing hair loss helps reduce the emotional toll of a diagnosis. It allows patients to face treatment with pride and grace during an incredibly vulnerable time.

Without insurance coverage, many patients cannot afford this treatment. Supporting this legislation ensures access is based on need, not ability to pay.
