We urge you to also support their passage as they will bring about necessary changes to improve long-term care for the residents of Rhode Island. This legislation will:

- Increase the frequency of inspections of assisted living facilities with Special Dementia Care Units from biennial to annual
- Enable the formation of resident and family councils in assisted living residences
- Limit a facility's ability to charge rent and fees following a resident's death
- Require enhanced transparency of ownership for nursing homes, and limit their equity extraction to 3% annually.
