

TOWN OF BARRINGTON, RHODE ISLAND
A RESOLUTION ASKING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO AMEND THE TAX
EXEMPTION STATUTE FOR THE LEGALLY BLIND

WHEREAS, RIGL 44-3-12 provides a tax exemption for the legally blind; and

WHEREAS, this statute contains language regarding exemptions for the legally blind specifically in the Town of Barrington that is confusing and difficult to apply; and


WHEREAS, RIGL 44-3-12 provides a simple and easy to apply method for applying a legally blind tax credit in Charlestown and Jamestown; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Barrington would be better served by removing the confusing language related to the Town of Barrington from RIGL 44-3-12 and enacting similar language to the simple language applied in Charlestown and Jamestown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Barrington Town Council hereby respectfully requests that attached legislation be enacted by the General Assembly to simplify the application of a visually impaired tax credit in the Town of Barrington; and
2. This resolution shall take effect upon passage.
