RE: Westerly Board of Canvassers Support for S-2341 Sub A (Military and Disabled Voter Mail Ballots)

Dear Chairperson LaMountain and Hon. Members of the Senate Judiciary Committee:

The Westerly Board of Canvassers voted unanimously to support **S-2341 Sub A**, an act to preserve the secure and timely access to mail ballots for overseas U.S. citizens, military service members, and voters with disabilities. This act ensures mail ballots can be submitted privately and securely to state election officials for tabulation.

The voters who qualify under the provisions of this act by virtue of being overseas, serving on active-duty deployments, or eligible disabled as defined in the legislation, require additional accommodations to ensure their ballots are received and counted. The Secretary of State continues to maintain a secure system to allow this classification of mail ballots to be securely and independently submitted. Without passage, these ballots will be required to be submitted through less secure platforms such as personal electronic mail or facsimile. Federal law requires this category of voters to be afforded additional protection and not to face an undue burden on participation in our democratic process.

Notably, this method of voting has been used successfully by voters to return mail ballots and by state election officials to receive and tabulate ballots in previous elections. This legislation continues the existing program that had a sunset provision expiring last year. Prompt passage will ensure the same access continues into and beyond the 2026 elections.

I respectfully encourage you to consider passage of **S-2341 Sub A** to preserve the existing rights of overseas U.S. citizens, military service members, and voters with disabilities.
