Re: Support of Senate Bill 3113

Dear Chairman LaMountain and Members of the Senate Committee on the Judiciary,

As the Election Administrator for the City of Newport and on behalf of the Newport Canvassing Authority, I am writing to encourage you **to support passage of Senate Bill 3113**. Introduced on behalf of the State Board of Elections, this bill would move the deadline for state and federal recount requests from seven (7) days to nine (9) days after the election. This bill has the support of the RI Town & City Clerks Association and the Secretary of State.

By moving this deadline for state and federal candidates, we would effectively align all the deadlines with the new local recount request deadline passed last year. This was changed to nine days after the election to allow for the transmission and counting of ballots for military and U.S. citizens to take place before a recount request needed to be filed. Under state law, these voters have seven days post-election for their ballots to be received and counted.

Thank you in advance for your consideration of this important, common-sense legislation.
