RE: SENATE BILL 3113 – AN ACT RELATING TO ELECTIONS -- CONDUCT OF ELECTION AND VOTING EQUIPMENT, AND SUPPLIES

Chair LaMountain and Honorable Committee Members,

On behalf of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns, we write to express our support for Senate Bill 3113, which would extend the period to request a recount of votes from seven (7) days to nine (9) days, and ensure that no certificates of election are issued until any recount is completed.

This legislation, introduced on behalf of the State Board of Elections, addresses an inconsistency in current law that establishes different recount request deadlines for federal candidates compared to state and local candidates. This discrepancy creates unnecessary confusion and has the potential to undermine the uniform administration of elections across jurisdictions.

By standardizing the timeline, Senate Bill 3113 promotes fairness, clarity, and consistency in the electoral process. Allowing additional time for recount requests helps ensure that all candidates are afforded a reasonable opportunity to seek a review of election results, while also supporting election officials in conducting thorough and accurate recounts.

Maintaining public confidence in the integrity of our elections is of the utmost importance. This bill represents a practical and thoughtful step toward strengthening election administration practices in Rhode Island.

We respectfully urge your favorable consideration of Senate Bill 3113.
