Dear Committee Members,

I am writing to urge you to oppose S2726.

This bill would expand Rhode Island's mandatory firearm safety training requirement to cover all firearms, not just handguns, and increase the required training from two hours to eight hours, with a mandatory standardized written test. Rhode Islanders who want to purchase a rifle or shotgun would face a new training burden they have never faced before.

Mandatory training requirements before exercising a constitutional right make gun ownership more expensive and inaccessible. Eight hours of required instruction plus a written test creates a real barrier for working people with limited time and income.

Please vote against S2726.
